











## Waste Disposal Calendar 2025

<b>Garbage</b> 	<p>Household waste may only be disposed of in the official taxed garbage bags which are subject to a fee. <b>Tax stamps</b>	<p>Non-official garbage bags can be marked with a tax stamp corresponding to their size. These tax stamps are available at the municipal administration office.</p>								
<b>Basic fees</b>	<p>In addition to the taxed garbage bags and tax stamps, a basic fee is charged annually in accordance with waste regulations. The fees are billed to the property owner (landlord).</p>								
<b>Waste collection dates:</b>	<p>Waste collection is always on Mondays 7:00am. Following Easter and Pentecost holidays, collection takes place Wednesday April 23, 2025 and Wednesday June 11, 2025 respectively. The taxed garbage bags can be placed in the proper collection containers at any time. Incorrect or improperly placed garbage bags will not be collected.</p>

### Recyclables and special waste disposal

What	Where	How? Remarks
Plastics 	Marked container (Bring Plastic Back) by the community workshop.	In the proper collection bags. These bags can be obtained at the municipal administration office for the same price as the taxed garbage bags. The following plastics are to be used in these collection bags: plastic bags, plastic from magazines, six pack rings, plastic bottles and beverage cartons of milk, oil, vinegar, shampoo, cleaning supplies, detergents, food packaging, plastic garden containers, and yogurt cups.
Paper and cardboard 	Paper and cardboard is collected twice a year by the school on April 29, 2025 and October 21, 2025	Paper and cardboard must be separated, and each tied in bundles with string. These bundles should not be too heavy and should be no larger than 30cm high. On collection day, bundles should be left out and ready at 7:30am.
Glass bottles 	Glass container by the community workshop	Separate glass by color. Remove all other materials such as lids, caps, corks and any other metal or plastic pieces. Reminder! Porcelain, ceramics, terracotta, glass from windows, glass from car windshields, mirrors etc. do not belong in the containers! These should be taken to a disposal center.
PET bottles 	Bring PET bottles back to supermarkets for recycling or leave them in the designated PET containers by the community workshop.	Air out, cap on top! Pressed bottles allow for more space.
Aluminum 	Alu container by the community workshop	Belongs in the Alu collection container: beverage cans, aluminum foil, metal screw caps. Does not belong in the Alu collection container: food tubes, pet food trays, spray cans. These items can be disposed of at metal collection points.

Batteries		Return to points of sale.	Never dispose of in household garbage bags! Car batteries should be taken to a garage.
Garden waste		<p>Garden waste such as tree or shrub cuttings, bush or lawn cuttings, foliage, withered flowers, and kitchen waste (without any plastic paper, cardboard, or metal materials).</p> <p><b>Collection dates:</b>  March 26, April 30, May 21, <b>Thursday, June 12</b>,  July 2, July 23, August 6, August 20, September 3,  September 17, October 1, October 22, November 5,  November 19</p> <p>Collection is taken from the street along the following route:</p>	Garden waste such as lawn or shrub cuttings, bush and tree cuttings, foliage, weeds, fallen fruit, withered flowers (without any decoration material). Bundles should be no longer than 1m and maximum 30kg.
			
Organic waste		If possible, dispose of it in your own compost. Otherwise at the Tschingeley Disposal Center in Burglauenen.	Food scraps of vegetables and fruits, balcony and potted plants, kitchen leftovers, etc.
Waste oil		Oil collection by the community workshop	
Hazardous waste		Return small amounts to points of sale (Pharmacy or drug store).	Medicines, thermometers, acids, lye, chemical solutions, paint and varnish leftovers, herbicides, pesticides, etc.
Old textiles and footwear		Texaid container by the community workshop	Clean, still usable shoes and textiles (clothes, belts, bed covers, duvets, pillows etc.) in closed bags (any kind of bag can be used) placed in the Texaid container.

Electronic household waste		Return to point of sale or Tschingeley Disposal Center, Burglauenen	Tip: Electric devices bought from Landi can only be brought back to Landi free of charge.
Tires		Return to point of sale.	Old tires can also be brought to Tschingeley Disposal Center, Burglauenen, for a fee.
Illuminates and lamps		Return to point of sale or Tschingeley Disposal Center, Burglauenen	Important! Neon, Fluorescent, and energy saving bulbs are not to be broken and do not belong in household garbage bags.
Constructions waste		The local transport company has the necessary resources and options for disposal. ENTRAG: 079 330 25 31 or GmbH: 079 439 42 30 Brawand Transport	The disposal of construction rubble, construction waste and commercial scrap metal waste is the responsibility of the builder or entrepreneur.
Wooden waste		Free of charge Mondays from 9:30 to 11:30 am at the Heizentrale der Holzwärme Grindelwald, Endweg 75, 3818 Grindelwald, <a href="http://www.holzwaerme-grindelwald.ch">www.holzwaerme-grindelwald.ch</a>	Only small quantities up to 200kg are accepted. Individual pieces may only be 1m long, have a maximum diameter of 25cm, and contain no metal fittings.
Animal carcasses		Should be brought to the confiscation room by the Talgielti workshop in Grindelwald.	Meat waste product (innards, bones, fats) and slaughterhouse waste (skins, bristles, feathers).
